2024 Post-Secondary Scholarship Award Application Form

Application Guidelines and Other Information:

- CFOFO will be awarding scholarships valued at \$500 each.
- Complete application packages must reach the CFOFO Scholarships & Awards Committee by **11:59 pm** on **September 15, 2024** (*no exceptions*).
- Applicant must be a Canadian citizen, or a permanent resident of Canada aged **25 years or under** as of December 31,2024.
- Type or print legibly. Illegible application forms will be returned to the applicant. You may also download a copy of the application form online: www.cfofo.ca.
- Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements, application process and a list of supporting documents required.
- Applicant's will be notified by email by mid-July regarding the status of their application. Interviews for successful applicants from round one will be held in late-September either via Zoom or in-person.
- CFOFO highly encourages those individuals who have participated, volunteered, and supported CFOFO initiatives to apply. However, this is not the sole deciding factor, and the scholarship is **open** to all applicants.
- Part-time studies (i.e., night school, etc.) programs/ correspondence courses do **not** qualify.
- Previous CFOFO Post-Secondary Scholarship Award winners do **not** qualify.
- The scholarship money will be paid directly to the individual upon proof of payment of tuition fees to a recognized post-secondary institution for the 2023-2024 school year. Please note that funds **cannot** be issued before **November 10,2024**.
- CFOFO will announce the recipients at the **CFOFO Community Awards Gala on Sunday, November 10, 2024 at Annacis Research and Event Centre** (1400 Lindsey Pl., Delta, BC V3M 6V1). **Recipient or a designated representative of the recipient MUST be present,** <u>in</u>
